
Promoting telecommuting:

- Launching reporting mechanisms for transparency, management monitoring
- Holding focus group discussions to identify best practices, challenges, ways to provide better support

Expanding shuttle services:

- Launched pilot routes for Potter St and N Berkeley BART
 - Added stops on Potter St, rerouted N Berkeley
 - Added runs on both routes, increasing N Berkeley van size
 - Informed by population distribution and employee input
 - Coordinated routes with AC Transit, City of Berkeley
 - Modernize shuttle accessories


