serve areas around the Cal campus, the Rockridge and Downtown Berkeley BART stations, and many of our off-site work locations.

or the Bike Express with your bike securely loaded on a bike rack.



Carpooling and vanpooling are excellent commuting options to reduce stress, make

friends, and save money. Take advantage of carpool lanes on freeways as well as designated carpool parking spaces on the Hill.



BART and AC Transit provide excellent connections to the Lab shuttles. Use pre-tax

dollars to ride public transit and reduce commute costs.
