- 20% of LBNL programs/people are in offsite facilities in leased space

Current Program Locations



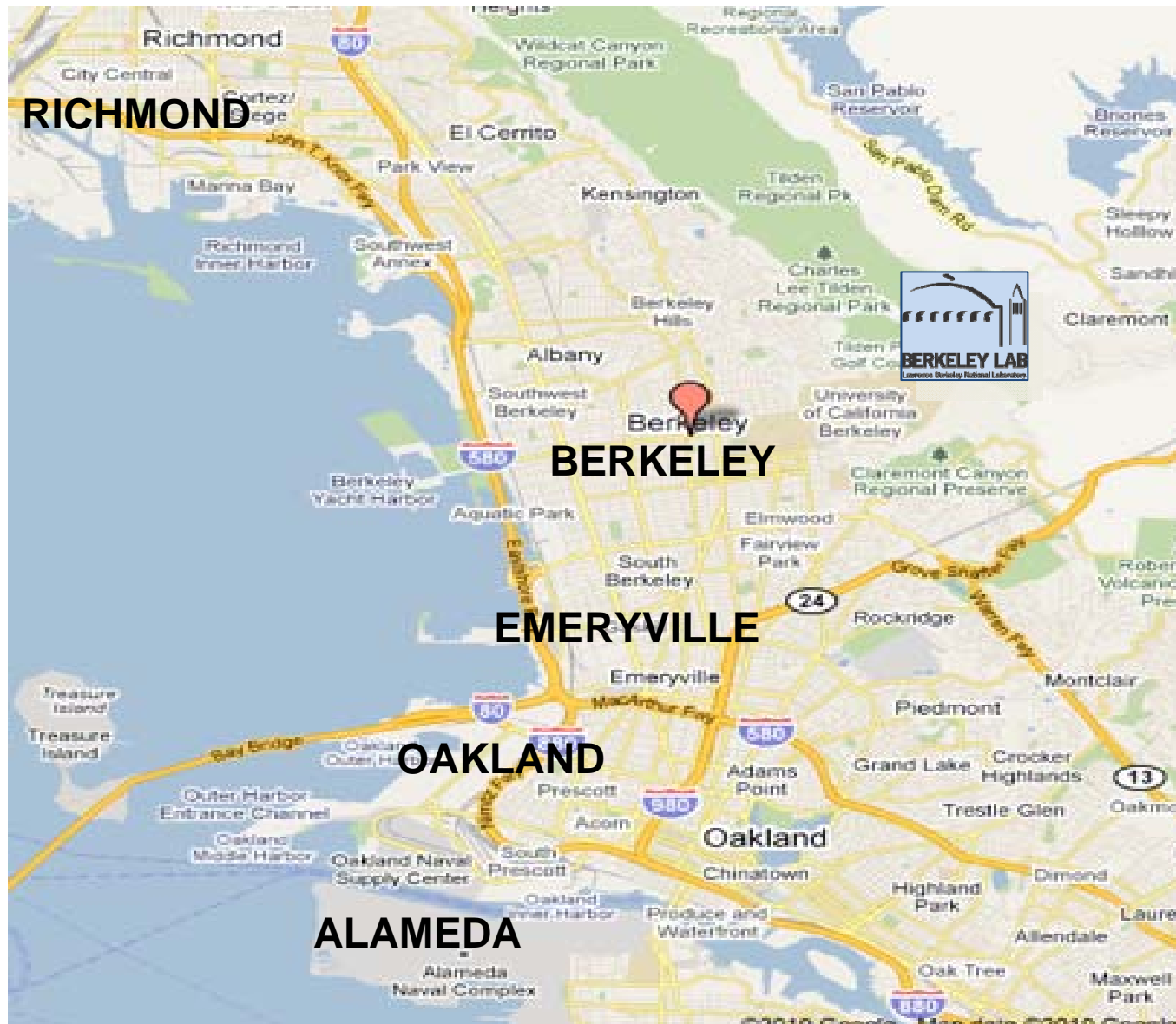
Why a second campus?

- 20% of LBNL programs/people are in offsite facilities in leased space
- Benefits of co-locating research
- Research programs are still growing
- Community support for alternate location

Attributes of an Ideal Site

- Close to Hill site: not > 20 minute travel time
- Adequate size: 30-50 year planning horizon
- Utilities: capacity / renewables
- Affordability
- Sustainability
- Accessibility
- Available Public Transportation
- Amenities near the site
- Community Support

Possible Second Campus Options



Conceptual Process

- Meetings with UC, DOE, CAG
- Determination of site requirements
- Formal Request for Proposals late fall
- Evaluate sites and select 2 to 4 for detailed look-winter 2011
- Final site selection - summer 2011
- Environmental Review Process - through 2012
- UC and DOE final approval and financing
- Design, site preparations, construction - 2015?
