### **Job Hazard Analysis**

It is a requirement that all personnel, including participating guests and students who are expected to work at the Berkeley Lab for thirty days or more, complete the Job Hazard Analysis (JHA) to identify pertinent environment, safety and health (ES&H) requirements. New personnel must complete the JHA within the first thirty (30) days of commencing work at the Berkeley Lab. Each person and their Supervisor or Work Lead must sign the JHA. Only work that has been authorized through the JHA process can be performed, and only after all controls are in place (including training). Working without a JHA can be done only under direct supervision. The JHA website is <http://www.lbl.gov/ehs/jha/>
