- **Salary Cap reduced to Executive Level II for awards with initial date on or after December 23, 2011.**
- **Effective date can be confusing.**
- **Does not apply to NCE and Carryforward where Executive Level I was permitted.**

FY 2012 Fiscal Policy

- Non-competing awards will be issued without cost of living/inflationary adjustment.
- Adjustments for special needs will be accommodated.
- Competing awards and applications should not have cost of living/inflationary adjustment.
- NRSA will have a 2% increase at all stipend levels.
