# Added DOE Approvals on Foreign Funded Proposed Projects

---

- **DOE Memo on 4/16/12 from Director of the Office of Science requiring approval from HQ Office of Science for any non-DOE funded project proposal “directly funded by a foreign sponsor”. BSO notified us on May 1, 2012 and it is effective immediately.**
- **The DOE cognizant program office must also be notified of the proposed work.**
- **Both the new approval and notification are in addition to the existing approval required from the HQ International Affairs Office.**



## **Added DOE Approvals on Foreign Funded Proposed Project (Cont.)**

---

- A New Form is required by DOE to implement the new requirement.**
- OSPIP will fill out the new form based on information contained in the proposal but we need from the Division the name, email address, telephone, and organization name for the cognizant program office within DOE.**
- The DOE BSO will email this contact person a copy of the New Form for each proposed Foreign Sponsor project.**



## **Added DOE Approvals on Foreign Funded Proposed Project (Cont.)**

---

- Put this new information in the RAPID Non-Federal WFO Proposal Review Factor entitled Work with/within DOE Mission. Only for Foreign Sponsored proposals.**
- For CRADA's add the email address to the existing section on Program Contact. This is only required for Foreign Sponsored Funds In CRADAs.**
- At this time, only the new form will be sent to Office of Science and the cognizant program office contact not the full proposal.**



## **Added DOE Approvals on Foreign Funded Proposed Project (Cont.)**

---

- We have no estimate on how long the additional approval will take. The DOE BSO will send the new form to the Office of Science and cognizant Program Official contact in parallel with the request for International Affairs Office approval.**
