


# RPPR - Overview

- Part of process to establish a uniform format for interim reporting on Federally-funded research.
- RPPR is NIH's implementation of the broader OMB RPPR.
- Official RPPR website is hosted by NSF at <http://www.nsf.gov/bfa/dias/policy/rppr/index.jsp> and like the Government-wide Standard Terms and Conditions, outlines each agency's implementation plans

# NIH RPPR Replaces eSNAP

- **Decide before starting RPPR or eSNAP**
- **Once started, must finish with that report**
  - **eRA Help Desk can re-set (but that may take a couple of day before they can get it reset)**
- **Looks very much like eSNAP**
  - **Structure slightly different – for a live demo, view the NIH webinar, or refer to the PowerPoint slides available on the NIH RPPR website**
  - **Some additional information is required for standardized federal reporting**

  - F. Changes
  - G. Special (NIH) Reporting Requirements
  - H. Budget – SF424 (R&R) forms
- Budgets coming in the future



# RPPR or eSNAP? That is the question

---

- **Until April 2013: option to use RPPR or eSNAP**
- **Decide before starting RPPR or eSNAP**
- **Once started, must finish with that report**
  - eRA Help Desk can re-set (but that may take a couple of day before they can get it reset)



# How to Get Started on RPPR

---

- In eRA Commons choose eSNAP or RPPR
- Navigation and Routing similar to eSNAP
- Delegation of Authority by PI to Staff is the same for eSNAP and RPPR



## ...from the NIH Webinar

### Summary of New Information Requested

- **Competitive revisions/administrative supplements**
  - Specific location to report aims & accomplishments (B.3)
- **Foreign Collaborations:**
  - Individual affiliation with foreign organization (D.1)
  - Dollar amount of award spent in foreign country (E.4)
  - Information about foreign components (G.9)
- **Participants – role on project**
  - New role-High School Student; slight rewording of other roles (D.1)
- **Level of Effort**
  - Prior approval request for reduction of >25% for PD/PI or other individual designated on NoA (D.2.a)
- **Estimated unobligated balance**
  - Provide estimated amount and description of how funds will be spent (G.10)



# Progress Report Add'l Materials (PRAM)

- If additional information is needed after submitting the RPPR, there will be:
  - Email notification to the PI
  - a link inside of eRA Commons

Status Result - List of Applications/Grants

- Important: The NIH provides the JIT (Just in Time) link in the Commons for applications receiving a percentile of less than 30 or for applications receiving a priority score of between 10 and 60 if no percentile is provided. Please await instructions from the NIH on whether to complete this information.
