# Related B&R Change in RAPID

- **RAPID will now only accept 1 Related B&R Code**

# The Warning/Error Message

---

## You may see this error/warning message.

There must be one and only one related B&R for every proposal (24000,27)

It is necessary to derive a unique Assistant Secretary Code from the related B&R. Thus only one is allowed. If you are in the submission component and the you've attempted to change the submit status to SUBMITTED, you will not be able to save until you've assigned a related B&R on the Related BNRs page. Otherwise this is just a warning and you can save.



## Error or Just a Warning?

- **Warning (and you will be able to save your proposal)**
  - When creating a proposal and you haven't entered any Related B&R Codes yet
  - When editing a proposal started before the change went into effect that already has more than one Related B&R code
  - When OSPIP Contract Officers is updating the proposal with new information
- **Error (and must be cleared in order to proceed)**
  - When changing the proposal to “SUBMITTED” status in order to generate an award



# How to Proceed?

- Division must make a decision about the most relevant or predominant Related B&R Code and delete the others.
