

Updating the Period of Performances in proposals:

1. If you want to have a later start date:
 - Update the start date first in Overall Budget and the start date of each period.
 - Then, update the Start date in the Proposal Header.
2. If you want to have an earlier start date:
 - Update the Proposal Header first
 - Then update the Start date in the Overall Budget and the start date for each period.
3. If you want to have an earlier end date:
 - Update the Overall Budget and the end date for each period.
 - Then update the End Date in the Proposal Header
4. If you want to have a later end date:
 - Update the Proposal Header
 - Then, update the End date in the Overall Budget and the end date for each period.
5. If your new start date is later than the end date, you correct your end date first with the new end date and then the start date.
6. If your end date is earlier than the current start date, you correct the start date first and then the new end date.
7. Additional Information regarding POP if you do PS Query:
 - The Begin and End Dates in the Award Modification Table (GM_AWD_MOD) are not the same as the LBNL_737. If you do connect them, unclick them as joined criteria or your information will be skewed.
8. Additional Information regarding the difference of the Award Header POP and the POP on the Project Setup:
 - The End Date in the Project Setup is actually the expiration date that the funding is available. The End Date in the Award Header reflects the entire project period and may not match of the expiration of current funding.
