



Co-PIs in eSRA (for non-NIH proposals)

This document shows a change in eSRA to add a category of personnel called Co-Investigator for non-NIH proposals in View 4.x. In NIH, this type of person was already in eSRA identified as "Multiple PI."

Why are we making this change?

- Revised reporting (submitted quarterly for proposals and awards) to UCOP now requests information about Co-PIs.

Who are Co-PIs?

- This should not be confused with Co-Investigators which would continue to be identified as Senior/Key Personnel. A Co-Investigator generally does not carry the same level of responsibilities that a Co-PI would carry.
- The Co-PI field should be used only when there are Co-PIs (as defined by the sponsor) on the proposal.

How does this new field work?

- Co-PI will not be an option on NIH proposals, or, in the future, on non-federal proposals that are NIH flow-through.
- Adding this type of personnel in eSRA for non-NIH proposals will function the same as adding any other type of personnel for LBNL and non-LBNL people.
- Co-PIs will be populated in the SF424 just like the Senior/Key personnel.
- The Co-PIs will be reported to UCOP.
