



## Accessing eSRA from Outside the Lab's Firewall (VPN)

This procedure provides instructions on how to access eSRA using VPN (Virtual Private Networking)

Because eSRA is protected by LBNL's firewall, you must be inside the firewall to open eSRA, or have VPN installed on your computer, laptop, cell phone or other external device prior to opening eSRA.

Follow the instructions provided by the IT Infrastructure LBLnet Services Group to install VPN on your device(s).
