Customers who are exempt include:

- ✓ Customers who purchase First, Business or full-fare Economy Class tickets
- ✓ AAdvantage Executive Platinum[®], Platinum[®] and Gold[®] members, **oneworld** Alliance Emerald, Sapphire and Ruby members
- ✓ Customers flying on the same reservation record as an AAdvantage Executive Platinum, Platinum or Gold member, **oneworld** Alliance Emerald, Sapphire or Ruby member regardless of frequent flyer status or fare type (excludes group bookings)
- ✓ Customers flying on AA codeshare flights not operated by American Airlines, American Eagle, or AmericanConnection
- ✓ Customers traveling on an international itinerary
- ✓ Active U.S. Military personnel traveling on orders or personal travel, or active U.S. Military dependents traveling on orders
- ✓ First and Business Class MileSAAver[®] Awards
- ✓ First, Business and Economy Class AAnytime[®] Awards
- ✓ First and Business Class upgrades confirmed prior to check-in
- ✓ Customers traveling on an AAirpass[®] ticket
- ✓ Charges apply if a bag is overweight or oversized
