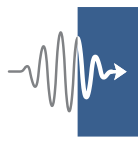

The Berkeley Marina Doubletree offers a special rate that meets government expense guidelines for SORMA West 2008.

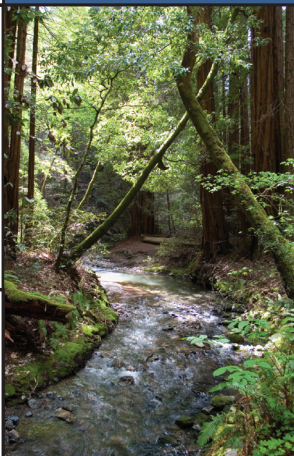
