Dear Mr. Jelinski:

This letter will serve as a permit for you to enter Wildcat Creek in Tilden. You may enter for the purpose of surface water and sediment sampling.

Special conditions regarding your request include:

1. You must contact the Park Supervisor at least 24 hours prior to your entry into the park. **Failure to communicate with the Park Supervisor may result in revocation of this permit.**
2. No vehicular access on EBRPD land.

Upon completion of this study, you will provide this office with a written summary of your findings, which may include any papers or published articles.

The term of this authorization is for one year, and shall be subject to the following standard conditions:


1. That you and your research associates abide by the rules and regulations as set forth in Ordinance 38. Park rules are available at the respective park kiosk, signs and public information centers and can also be found at http://www.ebparks.org/district/ord_38/ord_38TOC.htm.
2. That you and your associates each have a copy of this letter in your possession and post one on your vehicle as evidence of your authorization to do research in this park.



3. You agree that East Bay Regional Park District shall not be liable for any bodily injury, sickness, disease or death of any person or for damages to any property as a result of this Permit. In consideration of being permitted to enter the Property and perform the work under this Permit, you agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the East Bay Regional Park District, its directors, officials, agents and employees (collectively "District") from and against any and all actions, claims, demands and liabilities for any loss or damage, including claims for bodily injury, sickness, disease or death or property damage, arising from, relating to, or resulting from the entry onto the Property and/or the performance of activities under this Permit.
4. Should any member of the public question your project, you will take the time to explain the purpose of this activity and that such activity is undertaken through this permit process.
5. Because you are working on a mutually beneficial exercise, we are obliged to waive the normal \$50 permit fee.

If these terms and conditions are acceptable, please sign both copies of this letter and return them to this office. We will then send one copy, signed and approved by the Assistant General Manager, back to you. Thank you.


