

Ensure emergency resources are in maximum readiness, before, during, and after any emergency

Emergency Preparedness (EP)



Undertakes coordinated planning for:

❖ **Earthquakes**



❖ **Wildland Fires**



❖ **Energy Disruptions**



❖ **Terrorism**

❖ **Other lab-wide disasters**

❖ **Recovery/Resumption**
