What is Considered Hands-On Work In PUB-3000 Chapter 31?



Hands-on work includes:

- Use of hand or power tools
- Repair or service of a device, apparatus, machine mechanism
- Material handling
- Handling or disposing of a chemical, compressed gas, or hazardous, radioactive or bio-hazardous material



Hands-on work does not include:

- Office and administrative duties
- Computer programming
- Attending or making a presentation
- Supervision of a worker who is not performing hands-on work
