Guidelines for SAA Management

- Containers must be **labeled**
- Containers kept **closed** at all times except when adding waste
- Containers must be **compatible** with contents
- Physically separate wastes that may react if mixed
- Sort wastes that may react with one another into different **secondary containers**
- Your wastes must be appropriately segregated
- Only like wastes can be accumulated in the same container
 - Acids and bases in separate containers
 - Aqueous and organic liquids in separate containers
 - Halogenated and nonhalogenated solvents in separate containers

Your SAA may contain the following items:

- Secondary containment** (required for all liquids and glass containers)
- Waste items with **Hazardous Waste labels** (completely **filled out**)
- Funnels or other waste transfer equipment
- Other items (empty containers, chemicals, etc.) are not allowed in the SAA because they may be mistaken for unlabeled Hazardous Waste**
