



# SAA Reminder



Avoid SAA deficiencies by following these reminders:

- All hazardous waste containers **must be in an SAA**
- **9 month storage limit** on each waste container
- Liquid wastes and wastes in glass containers must have **secondary containment.**
- Incompatible wastes must be **properly segregated**, including separate secondary containment.
- Ignitable liquid wastes **greater than 1 quart must be in red “flam can”.**
- Waste containers kept **closed when not adding waste.**
- All containers must have **“Hazardous Waste” label completely filled out.**
