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Issues & Barriers

- **Communication**
 - A need for understanding capabilities, needs, opportunities, and constraints on both sides
- **Time to establish collaborations (CRADA, WFO, [ACT])**
 - A need for understanding the constraints on both sides
 - Approval process is simply too long
 - Export control
 - Prepayment

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Issues & Barriers

- **One size does not fit all**
 - Small business does not have the same resources as multinational corporations
- **Lack of uniformity / lack of flexibility** (competing issues)
- **Lack of understanding of best practices for potential collaborators – what works/what does not work**
- **Perception that labs are prioritizing profit (royalties) over technology deployment**
- **Labs do not have same rigor in tracking successes and failures as industry**
- **Mutual trust**

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Recommendations

- **Communication**
 - Focused, multilevel outreach
 - Segmented industry working groups
 - Centralized bidirectional Web site – capabilities, expertise
 - Agreed-upon principles of engagement
- **Time to establish collaborations**
 - Quickly implement, and track, Agreements for Commercializing Technology (ACT)
 - Continue to simplify CRADA and WFO processes
 - Revisit DOE’s prepayment policy

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Recommendations

- **One size does not fit all**
 - Explore methods to make labs more accessible to small business
- **Lack of understanding of best practices**
 - Create transparency for prior successes and failures – systematic case studies
- **Technology deployment**
 - Continue to emphasize technology deployment over royalty revenue as metric of success
