EHS 274 - Confined Space Entry - Refresher Training Course Syllabus

Subject Category: Industrial Hygiene

Course Length: 1-3 hours **Delivery Mode:** Classroom

Frequency: Every 3 years, or more frequently as needed.

Course Prerequisite: EHS 0275

Medical Approval: None

Course Purpose: The purpose of this refresher course is to help to ensure that employees who may enter or are involved with planning an entry into a Permit Required Confined Spaces have the requisite knowledge and skills to do so safely and in accordance with the requirements of LBNL's Confined Space Program.

Training Compliance Requirements: 29 CFR 1910.146 (g) and 29 CFR 1926.1200 Subpart AA EHS 274 is required whenever there is a change in the Confined Space Program; the Program Manager believes that there are deviations from the LBNL procedures; or, inadequacies in employee knowledge or use of procedures.

Learning Objectives:

After completing this training the successful student will be able to:

- Identify a confined space
- Use the confined space inventory to find safe work procedures
- Explain when you:
 - Can enter without a permit
 - Can enter with a permit
 - Cannot enter
- Take appropriate action if you discover unexpected hazards in a confined space
- Use the Confined Space Field Guide 01 to ensure you follow safety requirements during preparation and entry into confined spaces
- Describe any recent changes to the LBNL Confined Space program
