The qualification process consists of an in-class or one-on-one knowledge component, followed by a hands-on knowledge application (skills demonstration) component.

## **Course Objectives:**

After completing this course, participants should be able to:

- Use an inspection sheet to effectively inspect a scaffold and its components to assess its readiness
- Identify existing and predictable hazards in the surroundings or working conditions that are hazardous to employees and take corrective actions to eliminate them.
- Determine the level of maintenance need to maintain a scaffold
- Erect, repair, move and disassemble the scaffold(s) you oversee
