Course Purpose: This course provides training in the safe use and care of filtering face piece respirators (dust masks). Dust masks may be used for protection from airborne viruses. The goal of this course is to ensure employees know how to properly use and care for a filtering face piece dust mask.

Course Objectives:

Upon completion of this training employees will be able to:

1. Recall the LBNL respirator requirements for the filtering face piece respirator.
2. Recognize NIOSH certificated respirators.
3. Demonstrate how to don and perform a seal check of a filtering face piece respirator (dust mask).
4. Determine if and when a filtering face piece can be reused.
5. Recall how to properly store a filtering face piece respirator.
6. Recall the use limitations of filtering face piece respirators.
7. Recognize who to contact with questions regarding respiratory protection.
