Course Purpose: This AHERA approved course provides students the opportunity to learn abatement techniques, air sampling, respiratory protection issues, containment construction, filtration systems, etc.

Audience: This course is intended for personnel involved with the oversight and supervision of the removal, encapsulation, enclosure, and repair of asbestos-containing materials for Class I and II operations, such as work involving the disturbance of asbestos containing materials, including surfacing materials, thermal system insulation, and miscellaneous materials, in quantities larger than can be contained within a single waste or glove bag less than 60 inches in width. This course satisfies the training requirements of Cal-OSHA's Class I and II Competent Person training for asbestos.
