EHS 0389 Cord and Plug LOTO for Authorized Persons

Course Prerequisite: No Medical Approval: No Refresher: Every 3 years

Course Purpose: This course authorizes workers to apply Simple LOTO for cord-and-plug equipment. Course also explains the LOTO exemption for cord-and-plug equipment. Unless you are already authorized to perform Complex LOTO, you must successfully complete this course in order to be authorized to perform any work inside cord-and-plug devices using LBNL's Simple LOTO process.

Who training is for: Workers who perform work on electrical cord and plug equipment and implement Simple LOTO when exclusive control cannot be maintained.

Objectives:

After successfully completing this training, you will be able to:

- Recognize when LOTO is not required
- Identify who is allowed to use the Simple LOTO for Cord-and-Plug Equipment process
- Identify equipment that you can open up for maintenance or repairs without using LOTO, using Simple LOTO, and when Complex LOTO is required
- Choose appropriate locks and tags
- Enter the required information on your LOTO tag
- Apply your lock and tag correctly
- Properly control your key
- Safely release LOTO
