Course Purpose: EHS-802 is designed for Lab employees designated by their lab management as the Division Occurrence Reporting and Processing System (ORPS) Points-of-Contact. Other employees who serve as EHS staff, EHS Division Liaisons, Division safety managers, and Division Safety Coordinators may need this course. Training orients attendees to recognize their reporting responsibilities to DOE.

- Identify the roles and responsibilities of those involved in the Occurrence Reporting Process
- Given examples, determine whether an event is reportable through ORPS
- Given examples, determine the significant category of an event using a DOE ORPS flow chart.
- Given examples, determine the notification requirement
- Recall who to contact for assistance related to ORPS reporting
