Dear QM 2004 Authors,

The proceedings of QM 2004 will be published as a special issue of *Journal of Physics G: Nuclear and Particle Physics* and we are very eager to receive your contributions.

The submission process is very simple and will only take a few minutes to complete. The deadline for receipt of contributions is **March 15th 2004**. If we do not receive your article by the deadline we cannot guarantee its inclusion in the special issue.

What files to submit

When submitting your contribution it is important that you send us your original source code. Please note that PDF or PS files are not sufficient on their own, as these file formats cannot be used in our production process. We can accept any common variant of TeX or LaTeX. We can also accept MS Word files. Please remember to include your figure files.

Article Type: Special issue article

Comments: QM 2004 contribution

You can then upload the required files by following the instructions on the form.

E-mail submission

An alternative is to send your manuscript via e-mail, as an attachment. Please send it to jphysg@iop.org and ensure the subject line reads "**QM 2004 contribution**" so that your article can be easily identified.

You will be sent an initial acknowledgement by e-mail within a few days to confirm that your files have been safely processed. A subsequent e-mail will provide you with your article's unique ID number, which you can use to enquire about its status.
